RESEARCH

- The primary program of Australian Rotary Health (ARH) is funding research. The current focus is “Improving the mental health of 0–12-year-olds”.
- ARH also provides funding to PhD Scholars studying research in various health areas.
- The Rotary Club of Adelaide and District 9510 are joining ARH in the “Funding Partner” program to fund 2 PhD Scholarships at University of Adelaide, with a focus on the Prevention of Chronic Disease within the Aboriginal Communities. All donations received above the \$11,000 required each year for each scholarship, are not retained or utilised by ARH and will be remitted directly to the program as donations from SA Rotary.

- ❖ Australian Rotary Health also administers the “ARH Indigenous Health Scholarship” program which was initiated in SA. District 9510 has formed a sub-committee of the main ARH District Committee which works with ARH staff and the SA Government to ensure the smooth running of this program.
