Regional Council Election

Next month, Rotary and Rotaract clubs will be able to cast a **preferential vote** for each of the nine Regional Council positions they are eligible to vote for. The Regional Council will represent and support clubs at a regional level, so it is important that you and your fellow club members consider which candidate will be best for each role.

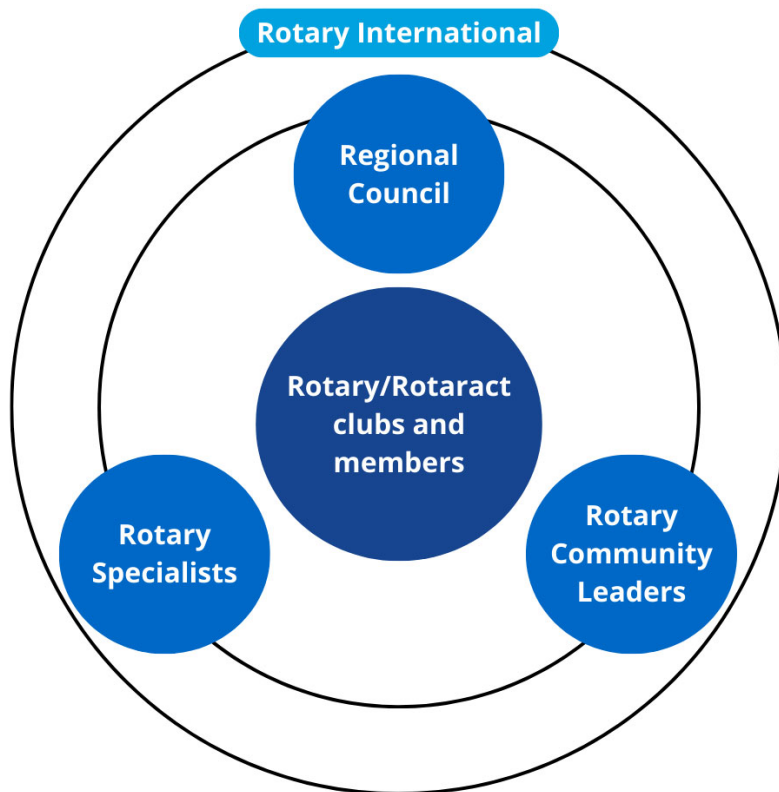
Club Presidents, Secretaries and Treasurers will receive further emails in the coming weeks about the election process, and will soon need to confirm the correct email address to which the ballot should be sent. This is an essential step to ensure all clubs have their say.

Voting opens on **Tuesday 17 October 2023** and closes on **Tuesday 31 October 2023**, with votes to be submitted by each club's designated Club Officer.
