

Registration times at the Conference Venue (The Precinct) :

- Registration at the conference will be open on Friday 15th March at the Precinct from 2.00pm until 5.00pm.
Those attending the Cocktail party are asked to Register beforehand, and collect their Lanyards.
- On Saturday 16th March the Registration Desk at the Precinct will open at 7.30.
Tea and coffee will be available
(Those attending the Foundation Breakfast are asked to move quickly to the Precinct at the close of the Breakfast.)

- **Re the Welcome Cocktail Party:** at the Historical Village on the Friday:

(1) Carparking at the Precinct.
