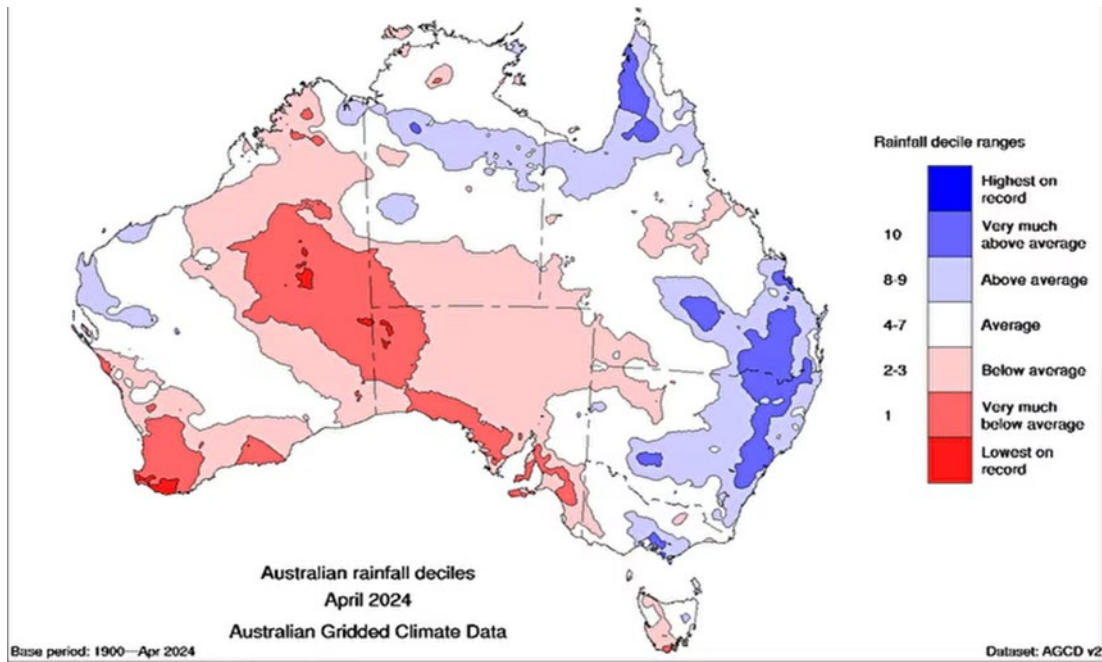


RAWCS Special Drought Relief Project.

There are rural families in our Rotary District whose income is being impacted by very low rainfall, and this is causing them economic stress.



Our Rotary District is in the fortunate position of being able to help distribute a large number of \$500.00 Drought Relief Debit Cards to these families.

The overall management of the Project Fund is through Rotary Australia World Community Service, (RAWCS) and our local District Drought Relief Committee is seeking a few Rotarians or Rotary Clubs in our Rotary District who are willing to carry out two tasks;

- RAWCS will identify the drought impacted communities, and there will be Rotarians and Rotary Clubs that can provide information to identify likely drought impacted families from these communities.
“Rural Business Support” is another organisation that has information about families in the drought impacted communities and we are also seeking their assistance to identify possible drought impacted families.
This identification process is confidential and very important
- Rotarians, Rotary Clubs are then asked to make contact with the families that have been identified, and offer them the opportunity to complete a \$500 Debit Card Application, and support them to email a scanned copy directly to RAWCS.

This process will result in a database of Names, email addresses and Postal Addresses which will be held by RAWCS.

There will be a confirmation check carried out by RAWCS, and in due course a \$500 Debit Card will be delivered to Applicants by Registered Post.
